General Plan Approvals/Permits

- GP-1 to GP-15, GP-19, GP-22, and GP-24
- GP-5 was revised on March 23, 2011
- To be revised again in 2012 to include final version of NSPS for SI engines
- It may also cover: condensate tanks, storage vessels, glycol dehydrators, reboilers, depropanizers, and equipment leaks.

- Guidance for Performing Single Stationary Source Determinations for Oil and Gas Industries
- DOCUMENT NUMBER: 270-0810-006
- October 12, 2011
- Five step analysis for PSD, Non-attainment NSR, and Title V applicability determinations

Boiler MACT

- 19 applications pending
- Most received in November 2009
- The EPA issued the Boiler MACT reconsideration proposal for major sources (40 CFR 63, subpart DDDDD) on 12/2/11
- The EPA proposed amendments to the Boiler MACT for area sources (40 CFR 63, subpart JJJJJ) on 12/2/11

The Cross-State Air Pollution Rule

- Final Rule: July 6, 2011
- Replaced 2005 CAIR
- Pennsylvania is one of the 27 states
- Compliance by January 1, 2012 for SO₂ and annual NO_X reductions and May 1, 2012 for ozone season NO_X reductions.
- DEP comments submitted to EPA on 11/28/11
