### Directions to Conference:

NJDEP Headquarters Building, 401 East State Street, Trenton, NJ 08625

#### From the North:

Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 9 (New Brunswick). Take Route 18 North for approx. 0.5 miles to Route 1 South. Follow Route 1 South to Trenton (when approaching Trenton, Do NOT take Business Route 1). In Trenton take Exit for "Market/E State/Train Exit". Turn right at end of ramp onto Stockton Street. At intersection of Stockton and East State Street turn right. Go over Route 1. NJDEP is on the right.

#### From the South and West:

Take Route 95 North or Route 295 North. Take Route 1 South towards Trenton; follow directions listed above.

#### From East/Shore points:

Take Route 195 West towards Trenton to Route 295 North. Take Route 1 south towards Trenton; follow directions above.

**Parking:** Public parking is available off East State Street just before the NJDEP building and also around the corner on Clinton Street.

**Mass Transit:** The DEP Headquarters Building is conveniently located near the Trenton train station (see [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com) for more info).
