

Directions to NJDEP

From the North:

Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 9 (New Brunswick), take Route 18 North for approx. 0.5 mile to Route 1 South, follow Route 1 South to Trenton (when approaching Trenton, please note: Do NOT take Business Route 1, stay on Highway Route 1), when reaching Trenton take Exit for "Market/E State/ Train Exit", turn right at end of ramp onto Stockton Street, at intersection of Stockton and East State Street make right, go over Route 1, NJDEP is at 401 E.State Street on the right

From the South and West:

Take Route 95 North or Route 295 North, take Route 1 South towards Trenton, follow directions listed above.

From East/Shore Points:

Take Route 195 West towards Trenton to Route 295 North, follow directions listed above.

Note: every effort was made to give quality directions, but please check an accurate map before your trip

Parking: Public parking areas are available off of E. State street just before the NJDEP building and also around the corner on Clinton street. Public parking signs are posted.

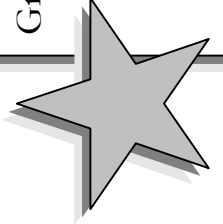
