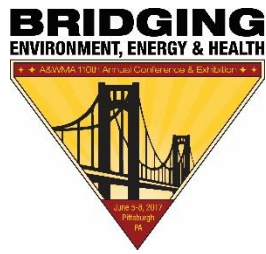

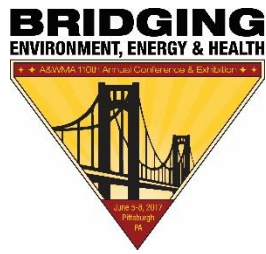

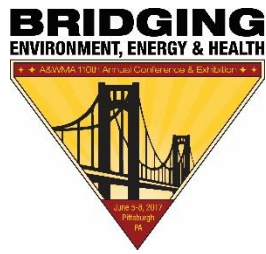

- Moderate climate with dining and attractions within walking distance of the Convention Center and hotel.

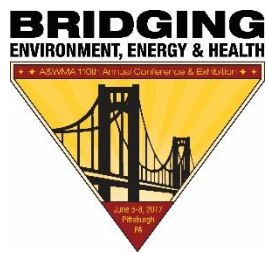
